Team Competition

Team Competition Rules (as few as we deem necessary, but enough to avoid any doubts and confusion) :

1. Runners and teams need to be registered and affiliated with either England Athletics or Association of Running Clubs.
2. Runners must be paid up members and registered with their club and their clubs affiliating body (EA or ARC) on the date of each race.
3. It is essential that individuals clearly state their club name when entering each race. It is the responsibility of each runner to ensure their club name is recorded on race entry forms.
4. The race results shall be those as recorded and published by each respective race organiser.
5. Standings in the Peak Half Marathon Series will be published ideally within 14 days of the completion of each race.
6. In the event that a runners club name has been omitted from the published results through genuine administrative error, the runner, nominated team captain or any committee member from their club should contact Peak Half Marathon Series in writing as soon as possible and ideally no later than 14 days after the Standings are published. Please note, evidence of affiliation may be requested as in 7 and 8.
7. Any challenge over the validity of an individual or club registration with EA or ARC must be made in writing to Peak Half Marathon Series within 14 days of the date of the race in question.
8. In the case of any disputed runner registration, Peak Half Marathon Series may request evidence of affiliation and club membership from the Secretary or Membership Secretary of the club in question. Valid affiliation shall be deemed evidenced by presentation from the club in question of payment to and receipt from relevant affiliating body.
9. Race rules will be those applied by each of the respective race organisers.
10. Any redress or protest at declared results at any one race should be made to the respective race referees.
11. Only results from completed races shall count.
12. Cancelled or abandoned races will not count towards the series.
13. Individual times and team points will be based on actual races successfully hosted. If 2 or more races are cancelled, the series will be cancelled.
14. If any race is postponed and re-run at a later date within the calendar year, we shall endeavour to include this in the final series results and standings. A separate communication to confirm this will be made in such an eventuality.
15. Peak Half Marathon Series is organised and administered by Ashbourne Running Club.
